BEGINNER

The focus is on listening, learning and reading music. Most people use books. Students already studying music start with a song.

CLASSICAL

Students learn to play and read classical music. Formal graded study leads to Conservatory Certificates. Practise suggestions for weekly enjoyment of music are discussed with both student and parent. Strict practice routines are suggested to ensure success with exams.



Jazz sessions focus on soloing, improvisation, chord voicing, modes, and swing. Advanced students learn jazz standards and transcriptions. Highlights include diminished, and melodic minor harmony, pentatonic soloing and upper structures. Performances by artists like Bill Evans and Gary Burton are studied.



Recording technology is the basis for study. Learn about controllers, interfaces, cables, microphones and monitors. Study software DAWS, beat-maker apps, audio and midi mixing. Use effects and virtual instruments to create electronic compositions and dance remixes.



Play lead synth lines and guitar anthems. Bend notes, trigger beats and play with different sounds and effects like delay, distortion and reverb. Get upfront and play in the spotlight.
